## Pledge-Raising Walker Recruitment: Phone Script

Hi \_\_\_\_\_, this is \_\_\_\_\_\_ calling about the upcoming Walk for Life Weekend. Is now a bad time to talk for 2-3 minutes? [Pause for response]

If YES: No problem. Is there a better time for me to call?

**If NO:** Great! Most women do not want to have an abortion. They feel trapped, like they need one. CompassCare provides women with free medical care and community support to give women the ability to say no to abortion, erasing the need for abortion in their minds.

I just love how we can serve women with the love of Christ through CompassCare because all people are made in the image of God and are equally valuable, both mother and child. So, I am participating in the Walk for Life Weekend as our church's CompassCare Liaison. I thought CompassCare's Walk for Life Weekend would be something you would be interested in [again].
