

Step 4: Host

A. Organize a watch party for the Online Rally at your home or church:

- a. **Pick a location:** CompassCare recommends hosting either at a home or at your church. The home setting is warmer and more intimate, offering the best opportunities for relational engagement. The church setting will typically provide more space and is a known location for guests.
- b. **Prep your space:** Make sure there is adequate seating with a good view of the screen. Plan ahead in case more guests attend than were expected.
- c. **Provide refreshments:** Food creates a celebratory and friendly atmosphere. You may want to invite one or two other Walkers on your Church Team to bring the refreshments so you as the host do not bear all of the responsibility.
- d. **Test your equipment:** Make sure audio and video are working 20-30 minutes before your guests arrive.
- e. **Plan for children:** The Online Rally is a family-friendly educational event and CompassCare recommends families watch together.

f. Host:

- a. Invite attendees to arrive around 6:30 PM (ET) for refreshments and fellowship.
- b. Access the Online Rally at 6:45 PM (ET) at CompassCareWalk.com or on Facebook or YouTube.
- c. A few minutes before the program begins, thank your guests for coming and share why you are passionate about serving women and saving babies through CompassCare.

B. Plan to meet up and walk together at the In-Person Walk:

- a. Pick a landmark in the festival area that can be easily found by everyone coming and/or bring a sign or flag with your church's name on it.
- b. Pick a time to meet up! Registration opens at 9AM and the Walk starts at 10AM.
- c. Consider praying together before, after, and/or during the Walk for women and their preborn babies.
